



INFORMATION FOR SELF-PUBLISHED AUTHORS

Wheelers is a well known online supplier of print books, eBooks, audioBooks and shelf-ready services to libraries and schools throughout New Zealand and Australia.

Libraries source books through Wheelers because they are contracted to use specific suppliers. For some we also cover and catalogue the books, so they are ready to go straight on the shelf. For this reason the libraries are unable to purchase books from you directly as the author/distributor.

Schools have more leeway when choosing suppliers, but will often go with who can offer the best price, fastest turn around or ease of ordering.

As Wheelers is a Library Supplier that operates on an order to order basis, we do not hold stock, market or distribute titles. If we do go ahead and list your title on our website, orders will be emailed to you as they come through from our customers.

Once receiving an order from us, we ask that you ship the book to our warehouse with an invoice, which includes your freight costs. Please use a bubble bag, or similar, to ensure it arrives in good condition. If you live locally it is fine to drop the books off to our warehouse in Glenfield, Auckland.

Your book will be reviewed to check its suitability, therefore it is very helpful if you can email us sample pages, illustrations or reviews. Please be aware that libraries and schools prefer books that are durable and well produced.

If your book is accepted, we will then email you a New Title form to complete with the details of your book, pricing and your information as the supplier.

If you would like your book to be available for public libraries/schools to consider ordering, then please read the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's) before contacting us.

FAQ'S FOR SELF-PUBLISHED AUTHORS

What is an ISBN?

ISBN stands for International Standard Book Number.

Booksellers and libraries need this printed on the back of the book to enable them to scan the book into their systems. All inquiries about a title feed off this number. You should obtain yours from the National Library of New Zealand: http://natlib.govt.nz/publishers-and-authors

What is a legal deposit?

Self-published authors are required to legally deposit physical formats and eBooks they have created to the National Library of New Zealand. You can find more information about this at: http://natlib.govt.nz/publishers-and-authors

Will Wheelers publish, stock or distribute my book?

Wheelers are an online retail supplier to libraries and schools across New Zealand and Australia. We do not publish, hold stock or distribute books. You can find more information about what we do at http://www.wheelers.co.nz/about/

Will Wheelers market my book?

Wheelers do not market books. If you are marketing this yourself we recommend that you contact libraries and schools and mention that it is available from the Wheelers website once your book is listed.

How do I get libraries or schools to buy my book?

You will need to market the book yourself and make it clear where it can be purchased from. Use websites, social media, radio interviews, articles in the paper and any other means to publicise your book. Your local library will often allow you to hold a book launch.

Can I bring my book in to show you/send you a copy?

We do not have time to see authors at our offices, but in some circumstances would like a copy of your book so it can be reviewed by our Selection team. If you would like to send a proof copy, please send an email first to see if this is appropriate and note these are non-returnable and sales cannot be guaranteed.

I already have a distributor for my book. Do I need to contact you?

We may have already received your book information directly from your distributor or through Neilsen BookData. Please check our website to see if your book is already listed.

I have used CreateSpace, or similar, to publish and sell my book. Can I also supply copies direct to Wheelers?

If your title is on our website already and you have used CreateSpace (or a similar overseas self-publishing distribution company), check the terms and conditions you have with them to see if you are permitted to sell direct within NZ or Australia. We

would be happy to list a 'local' price for your title, which can help lower the cost to our customers. Please contact us if you would like to be set up as a local supplier.

What does RRP mean?

RRP stands for Recommended Retail Price. This is the retail price you set for your book.

What price should I retail my book for?

The retail price is totally up to you, but do compare with what other books, that are similar to yours, are selling for.

What discount should I offer Wheelers?

A discounted price allows us to on-sell your book to our customers at a reasonable price. However, it is totally up to you what you can afford to sell the book to us for. Wheelers will add a mark-up to cover freight, handling and resources. If you are not GST registered, then this will also be added to the final price.

How do I work out freight costs to send my book to Wheelers?

If you live in New Zealand, work out the freight of shipping **1** book from you (or your supplier) to our main office in Glenfield, Auckland:

I have an eBook. How can you help me?

To retail your eBooks, we will need to sign a non exclusive contract with you. Please contact us for more information.

Why are my eBooks not showing on your website?

Only our ePlatform customers can see eBooks. If you are unsure if it is listed please contact us.
